Football Competition Rules

Sport Rules:

- 1. Pitch allocation/group draws for the AM competition will be done on a random basis.
- 2. The start and end of matches will be controlled by a match referee's whistle
- 3. The first named team will choose a goal. The second named team will kick off the match.
- 4. A goal cannot be scored from a direct kick off.
- 5. YELLOW CARD If a player receives two yellow cards they will be sent off and miss the next match.
- 6. RED CARD If a player received a red card, they will be sent off and will miss the next match.
- 7. The 'roll-on-roll-off' rules apply to substitutions. Substitutions can only be made during stoppages in play and with the approval of the referee.
- 8. Substitutions must wear a different colours top when not playing.
- 9. After a goal is scored, there will be a restart with a centre kick by the team who did not score the goal.
- 10. All free kicks are direct. Free kicks must be taken where the offence was committed, opponents must be five yards from the ball.
- 11. ANY type of throw can be made for any re-introduction to play EXCEPT corners, where the ball is placed and kicked in.
- 12. Goalkeepers are not allowed to kick the ball from their hands to introduce the ball into play.
- 13. The goalkeeper may leave the goal area.
- 14. Goalkeepers are not allowed to take penalties, expect during sudden death penalty shoot-outs.
- 15. Sliding tackles are not permitted.

Foul or abusive language will be penalised by the referee at their discretion by awarding a direct free kick.
