The aim of the School Games Competitions is to encourage the pupils in Greenwich to actively participate in sport, improve their health / wellbeing and to create positive experiences to encourage them to have a lifelong passion for sport.

## Pupils

- Participate for fun and enjoyment, as well as achievement
- Demonstrate team commitment and spirit
- Follow the rules of the game
- Respect opponents and the decisions of officials
- Use the six values whilst playing and waiting to play the game

## Teachers/Young Leaders/Officials

- It is the participating schools responsibility to organise their own designated first-aider for their school at each event
- Demonstrate proper personal behaviour and conduct at all times – positive role models
- Encourage participation in sport for fun, enjoyment and achievement
- Respect participants and the decisions of officials/young leaders
- Abide by the rules – be fair, honest and considerate and understand that results will only be released at the discretion of the School Games Organiser (SGO)
- Discourage poor sportsmanship
- Create and maintain a safe environment
- Use the six values to encourage all children and to be polite to teams, young leaders, officials and teachers (Determination, Respect, Self-Belief, Teamwork, Honesty, Passion)
- Please keep the environment clean at all times and to pick up rubbish as a team at the end of every event

## Safeguarding

- Schools will only bring employed staff members to any event or competition

- Staff attending will have an up-to-date DBS certificate
- Parents are not allowed to attend events

- Photos will be taken of sporting participants to be shared on the Greenwich School Sport Partnership – It is the participating schools responsibility to inform the competition organiser / SGO if there are any children without photo consent.
