The Inclusive Sport Programme delivers a suite of resources inspired by international disability and Para Sport events, including the Special Olympics World Games, the Winter and Summer Paralympic Games and the Commonwealth Games.

The resources support the delivery of inclusive programmes of sport and festivals, providing young people with and without SEND the opportunity to come together and participate in themed festivals based on these international events.

It has been designed to raise awareness of the importance of inclusion within sport and physical activity through education of each Special Educational Need and/or Disability (SEND). This new resource will support both School Games Organisers as well as educational practitioners seeking continual professional development in inclusive school sport practice.
